Overview:

The Jessica Prouty Band is comprised of teens from Marblehead, Swampscott, and Wilmington MA whose music crosses generations. This music is sometimes described as "if Evanescence (female-fronted-hard-rock band) scored a Shrek movie" because Jessica is a soprano like Amy Lee, and Shrek always has a playful, hopeful side even when mired in adversity. Also, like Shrek, this teen band breaks the common rock band stereotypes.
